Barry King will replace the door at the pavilion and will put on all cranks for the windows at the township hall.

The surveillance signs will be put up at the cemetery, recreation area and township hall.

The cemetery deeds are now completed. Judge Davis gave us a quick deed for the original land. Also a push lawn mover has been purchased along with a weed eater and will stay at the cemetery so the lawn work can be completed when

Purchasing new tables for the hall will be looked into in August to check out prices.

New Business: The Sheriff Department has not billed us for the "Noise Ordinance" patrol for the past two years. We will be writing a check for this for \$1,200.00.

A letter will be sent to the Joint Government Group to tell them to take our name off the list for Trash to Treasurer day. We supply vouchers for our own trash day. A 4-H group was given a voucher for L Road being they pick up the full road including 13 tires.

Treasurer Trombley-Robitaille moved to purchase two signs that will be put up on Rivers road "Slow Children" for a day care area. This will cost \$310.00 but the road does have 200 living on it and they do go fast. Trustee Gareau seconds this motion. Motion carried.

Property was discussed for the voting area in Lake Bluff Estates. A call will be made to Michelle DeWitt at CUPPAD to see if any money is available through a government grant.

Delta County Townships Association picnic will be held at our pavilion this year on July 23, at 5:30 p.m. Each Official will bring a dish and a hors d'oeuvre to pass.

The Assessor will have a 14-point review this year. They will be doing all of Delta County to see if the cards, maps, and etc. are all in order.

Supervisor Dubord signed a Municipal Finance Act that he will do every year now being we are borrowing the money for Bluff Drive's special assessment.

The janitors asked if the garbage can be picked up on Monday at the recreation center to bring to the hall so the trashcans are empty for doings at the hall on the weekend. They would also like the cans to be rinsed out each time.

Art Meyers was present to discuss his property line and a neighbors structure that is too close. The Zoning Administrator will go and see what can be accomplished pertaining to this dilemma. Mr. Meyers is concerned about loosing feet off his property.

Joe Demeuse asked to purchase sand from the township property off 0.8 Lane. The Board decided not to sell sand in case we need it for the walking trail around the property. An Eagle Scout needs a project for the township and maybe he can move

this sand for the trail.

The Brown Field Committee is looking for places to clean up as far as land. Carroll's Corners had a dozen wells cleaned in the past and are wondering if anymore need capping. Kelly and Jenna Lively can't drink their water so maybe something can be done for them. Dave Rivard will check into this for them.
